

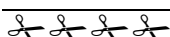

**WORCESTERSHIRE SENIOR MEN'S 31st COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP 2010
At Droitwich Golf Club – Wednesday 22nd September 2010**

Conditions

1. **The Competition** shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, and with the Local Rules of Droitwich Golf Club, as approved by the Championship Committee. The format is 18 holes Medal Strokeplay.
2. **Trophies** will be awarded to the overall Gross and Nett Winners. There are Best Gross and Nett Prizes in the following age groups, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and over 70, based on age on the day of the Championship.
3. **Time of starting:**
 - a) Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Championship Committee (Rule 6-3a). However it is a condition of this Competition that, if the competitor arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which would warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification, as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole instead of disqualification.
 - b) Competitors will be notified of their Starting Times by e-mail or post, which will also be displayed on the County website. A Practice Round on the course can be arranged during the preceding two weeks, by arrangement with the Professional. Contact the Professional, Mr Phil Cundy, on 01905 770207 to arrange a suitable time. A Practice Round Green Fee, £10, is payable beforehand.
 - c) The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and alter starting times.
4. **Entries:**
 - a) Championship entries shall be made on the Entry Forms, obtainable from Club Secretaries or the County website www.worcestershireamateurgolf.co.uk and must be received on or before the closing date, Saturday 11th September. Return of the Entry Form acknowledges and accepts the conditions of the Competitions and certifies that the competitor conforms in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status.
 - b) Players must be members of Golf Clubs affiliated to the Worcestershire Union of Golf Clubs. Players must have a Worcestershire Club as their "Home" club for C.O.N.G.U. handicapping purposes. The playing handicap limit is eighteen.
 - c) Entry Fees must accompany completed Entry Forms, cheques being made payable to "W.U.G.C.". THE INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FEE IS £25.

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- 5. **Entrance fees** will not be refunded in the event of an entrant having to withdraw after the closing date except for those entrants who may be balloted out and who do not subsequently compete.
- 6. **Committee:** Entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee, which reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving reason for its decision.
- 7. **The decisions of the Championship Committee** or its delegated officers shall, in all matters be final.
- 8. **Handicap and Qualifications:** Only amateur male members of Golf Clubs affiliated to the Worcestershire Union of Golf Clubs, and over 55 on the day of the competition may enter. There is a handicap limit of EIGHTEEN or better to enter, but entries will be restricted to the 100 lowest EXACT HANDICAP players, with a ballot on ties if necessary.
However, if an entrant has played at the Union Meeting of any other County, or has represented any other County, since 1st October 2009, then he is not eligible to compete at this meeting.
- 9. **Ties:**
 - a) In the event of a tie for the Championship there will be an immediate play-off over holes nominated by the Championship Committee. In the event of a further tie, play will continue over the same holes on a sudden death basis.
 - b) For all other prizes the competitor with the better or best score over the last 9, 6, 3 or final hole will be declared the winner. A player may only win one prize.
- 10. **Transportation.** A player shall walk at all times during a stipulated round. Caddies are permitted. Buggies are not permitted, unless a player is Disabled, as defined by Disability Discrimination Law.
- 11. **Matchplay Championship qualification.**
The first 8 Gross players will play in the Worcestershire Senior Men's Matchplay Championship.
- 12. **Jackets and ties will be worn in the clubhouse by all competitors, following play.**
